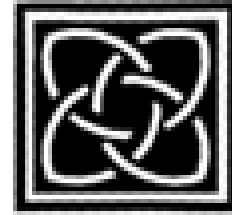

**Walls in the Westmorland
Landscape - Russendal
Speaker: David Johnson**



Drystone walls have a very old genesis and it is a commonly heard misconception that the majority of walls in the northern uplands date from the period of parliamentary enclosure, typically 1750-1850, though rather later in much of Cumbria. Many people are not aware of the great age of some walls. The WDLP Dry Stone Walls project, in Asby in 2022, is the first survey in Cumbria to adopt a comprehensive, comparative and synoptic approach to the study of walls in their landscape context. This talk summarises the methodology and results.
